A transcript of the student's grades must be received by the deadline given below. If it is school policy to mail transcripts separately, it is the applicant's responsibility to see that these transcripts are received at the UIA office. Applications without transcripts of grades will not be considered. In addition, a recent photo should be included with the application. This photo will not be returned to the applicant. It may be used for news releases or for publicity articles should your student receive a scholarship.

We hope you will encourage all students who are eligible to apply for one of these scholarships.
